ANN: 이제 시작하겠습니다.

1번 다음을 듣고, 대구의 날씨로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Good morning. Let's take a look at the national weather report. Today in Seoul, it will be sunny all day. Rain is expected in Incheon, so drive carefully. Sejong will see foggy skies. In Daegu, it will be cloudy, but no rain. Strong wind and heavy rain are forecasted in Busan. Have a nice day.
